Special Notices

Disable FortiExplorer access

FortiOS v5.2 introduced a CLI command to allow you to disable FortiExplorer access. FortiExplorer access is enabled by default.

To disable FortiExplorer access, enter the following command in the FortiOS command-line interface:

```
config system console
    set fortiexplorer disable
end
```

FortiAP Web-based Manager support

FortiExplorer v2.4 removed Web-based Manager support for FortiAP. FortiExplorer v2.4 and later supports the Command-line Interface (CLI) only.

The WiFi controller setting, *login-enable*, under WTP entry will determine if the managed FortiAP can be accessed through the FortiExplorer CLI.

This image includes the FortiExplorer MSI file.
- `FortiExplorerSetup_win_upgrade_2.6.1083.msi`
This image includes the FortiExplorer MSI file and the Microsoft Windows USB driver library. This upgrade image can be used on all Microsoft Windows operating systems.
- `FortiExplorer_OnlineInstaller_2.6.1083.exe`
This image is an online installer for FortiExplorer. When run, it will download the full installer from the FortiGuard Distribution Servers (FDS). This image can be used on a Microsoft Windows 7 operating system.

Bug ID	Description
0192440	Upload firmware from local hard disk to entry level models can fail.
0254332	MacBook sleep and wake up will cause FortiExplorer quit unexpectedly.
0258110	Microsoft Windows version failed to connect the public FortiCare server.

Bug ID	Description
0240334	After disabling and enabling login in the Command-line Interface, FortiExplorer cannot detect FortiGate correctly.
0241911	The FortiOS v5.2 USB driver does not support FortiExplorer on some entry level FortiGate models.
0243388	FortiExplorer displays a generic device picture for the FGR-60D model.
0250671	FortiExplorer displays a generic device picture for FG-92D and FWF-92D models.
0252210	Unable to activate FortiCloud using the FortiExplorer setup wizard.
0254345	FortiExplorer displays a generic device picture for the FG-500D model.
